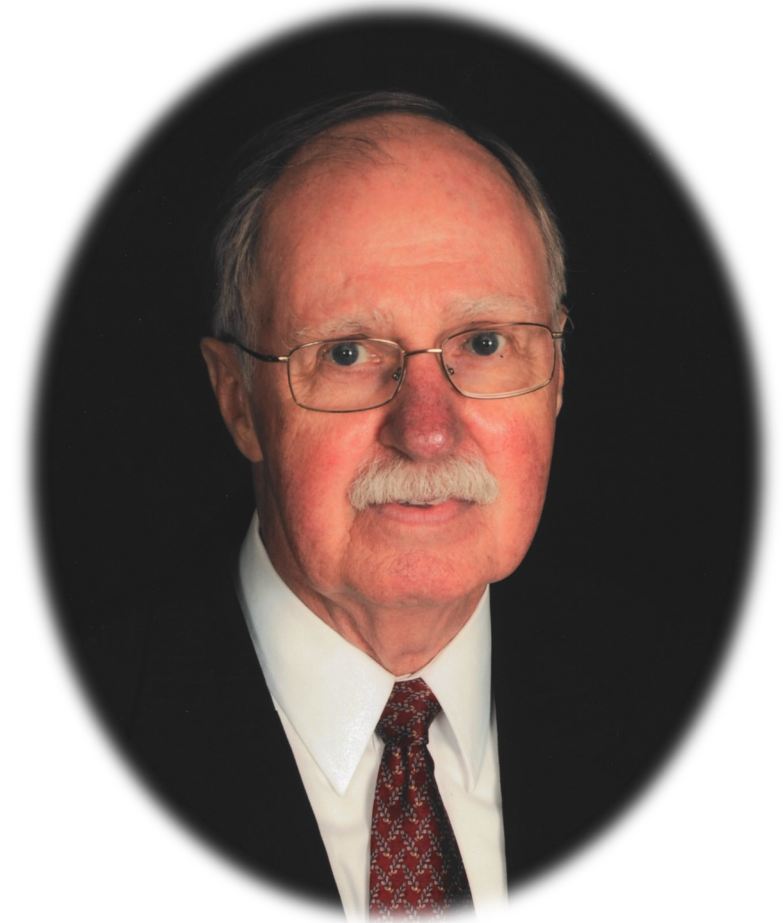


# *Celebrating the Life of*
