

Imagine you are a parent about to leave your children, knowing you will not see them again until the Kingdom of Heaven. What is the most important thing you could say to them?

- Top & Trim arborvitae plus other trees
- Pressure wash both buildings
- Reglue loose formica both buildings
- Touch up the stain all wood baseboards, doors, & trim Church
- Paint all exterior doors inside & out Church
- Check all light bulbs & tubes both buildings
- Repatch & seal black top
- Restrip black top lines (after sealed)
- Wash windows inside & out both buildings
- Paint Fellowship & Community Service Building
- Rake pinecones & needles
- > Finish leveling gravel from snow removal
 - Check rain gutters & downspouts plus joints both buildings
- Shampoo Fellowship Building carpet
 - ✓ Check all plug & switch covers replace if needed
 - ✓ Sanitize all door & cupboard handles, phones, railings both buildings
- > Team walk to find repairs observed.
- Clean & Sanitize Ovens in Fellowship Center
- > Patch all concrete cracks
- Clean Handicap Signs & poles
- Strip seal & wax all floor tile in both buildings
 - ✓ Cut down dead Austrian Pine Tree
 - ✓ Winterized Irrigation System
