Dupont Park Adventist School Policies and Procedures

Emergency Closing/Snow Days

In the event of snow emergencies, Dupont Park Adventist School will follow the Prince George's County Public School policy for delayed openings, early closings, and school closings. Listen to your radio (WTOP - 1500 AM) and check the television stations (Channels 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9) for details. Again, when Prince George's County Public Schools are closed for inclement weather, Dupont Park Adventist School will also close.

Before and Aftercare

When PGCS are closed, so is the Before and Aftercare of DPAS.

If PG has a 2 hour morning delay then,	DPAS before care opens 9:00 am
If PG has a 3 hour morning delay then,	DPAS before care opens 10: 00 am
If PG suspends all afternoon activities,	DPAS will NOT have aftercare.
