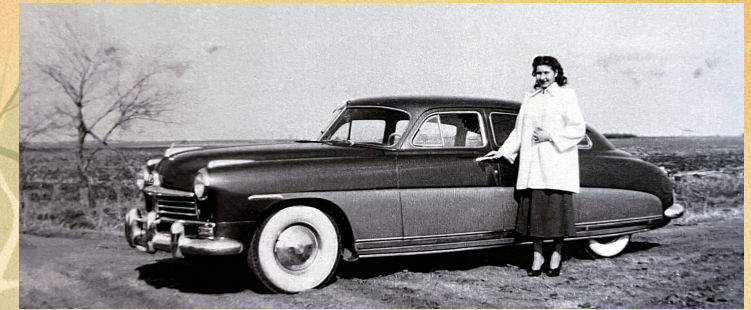
Estelle Mae Regier, 95, of Galva, KS, peacefully passed away on Saturday, November 2, 2024, surrounded by family at Brookdale, McPherson.

She was born on December 4, 1928, at her home in rural Galva, KS, the daughter of Albert P. and Clara (Koehn) Unruh. Estelle graduated from Galva High School in 1948. On May 1, 1949, she was united in marriage to Kenneth Lee Regier in McPherson, KS. This union was blessed with four children, Gemma, Teresa, Scott, and Troy. Estelle and Kenneth were married for 66 years prior to his passing on April 12, 2016.

Estelle was first and foremost an able homemaker. Since Kenneth was gone a lot for work, she often was on her own, responsible for four nearly feral children. She drove them to country school, countless 4H meetings, and vacation bible school every summer.

She learned bookkeeping in high school, working at her father's feed mill in Galva. She loved those orderly numbers and used her skill working at Newell's Corner in Newton and as a legal secretary for Jack Bowker in McPherson. Her last job was keeping books for Big Six Transport, her husband's trucking company. Her personal checkbook was always current and balanced to the penny, even a week before her passing.

Estelle loved the Lord and studied his word diligently. She and Kenneth enjoyed attending Wheatland Baptist Church, McPherson, and they both found joy with their church family. In her later years, she



watched Trinity Broadcasting Network after she could not attend regular church services. Up until her death, she was comforted by the faithful visits of friends and family.
