
CITATION TO ACCOMPANY THE AWARD OF THE AIR FORCE COMMENDATION MEDAL

TO

ROGER E. BEHM

Airman First Class Roger E. Behm distinguished himself by meritorious service as a Plumbing Specialist, Plumbing Shop, Operations and Maintenance Branch, 443d Civil Engineering Squadron, Altus Air Force Base, Oklahoma, from 30 October 1975 to 7 November 1977. During this period, Airman Behm has been largely responsible for the mission of effectiveness of this section, not only in the operational area, but in improving morale and by setting an outstanding example for both his supervisors and co-workers to follow. Due to his outstanding efforts, ability and devotion to duty, Airman Behm was continually assigned tasks which were normally assigned to an individual with a higher grade and skill level. The distinctive accomplishments of Airman Behm reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.





Roger Earl Behm was born in Grand Forks, ND on November 23, 1956, to Earl (Squirt) and Margaret Ann (Yoney) Behm of Niagara, ND. He attended school in Niagara and Petersburg, graduating in 1975. After completing school, he enlisted in the Air Force from 1975 and retired in 1979. He received the Air Force Commendation Medal for his valiant service. ing their three children and establishing Behm's Plumbing Inc. He built a successful plumbing business, serving the area for 48 years, and establishing additional branches in Mentor, Alexandria, MN and Mesa, AZ.

Roger served as a volunteer fireman for the Cavalier Fire Department. He also served as a board member for the Cavalier Country Club and the Maple Lake Association Board. He was a proud member of the American Legion and the Elks Lodge. Roger enjoyed hunting, fishing, traveling and being at the lake with his family and friends. He enjoyed watching his grandkids participate in their sporting events and activities. For the past few years, Roger and Marilyn enjoyed spending their winters at their home in Mesa, AZ.
