

OBITUARY

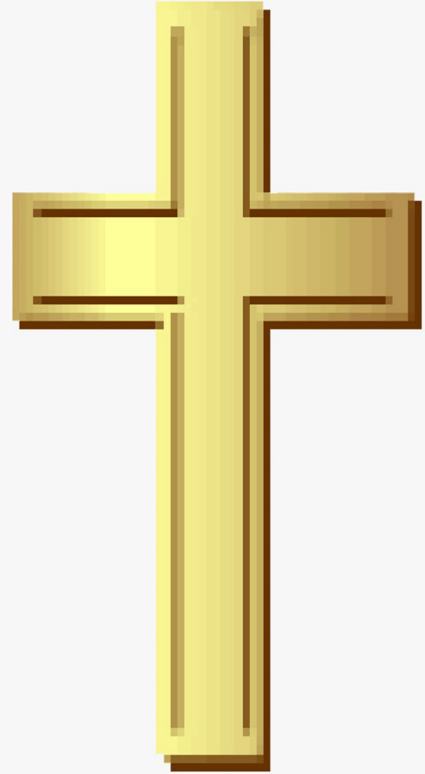
