### Responsibilities and Duties:

The Senior Coach shall be responsible for:

- Working with the Development Manager and the Squash and Racquetball Committee to select the 2019 Squash SA State Junior Team within the guidelines of the AJC SSA002 State Team Selection Policy
- Preparing the team for the tournament in conjunction with the Assistant Coach, once the team has been selected which will occur within 14 days of the conclusion of the SA Junior Age Championships. This includes management of court hire/training logistics from June-September.
- Planning and supervision of training sessions before departure and during competition.
- Consultation with the Team Manager on all matters and specifically on any issues that may arise in relation to team members.
- Using the current Squash SA state junior rankings and AJC individual event tournament results to select the order for the AJC Teams Event.
- The athlete's physical, mental and emotional well-being whilst on tour.
- Ensuring that the athlete's meals/diet, sleeping habits and recreation are conducive to optimum tournament performance.
- Fostering team spirit to enable all athletes to participate and perform at their best.
- Verifying and checking with management on all arrangements for:
  - \* Training Venues
  - \* Transport
  - \* Training Schedules
  - \* Tournament Venue
  - \* Meal times
  - \* Tournament Draws
  - \* Tournament Numbers
  - \* Tournament Times
- Advising the Assistant Coach of their responsibilities and
- Providing a detailed report to the Development Manager within 10 working days of the completion of the tour.

The Assistant Coach, in consultation with the Senior Coach, shall be responsible for:

- Preparing the team for the tournament.
- Planning and supervision of training sessions before departure and during competition.
- Establishing an agreed team ranking to achieve the optimum team result.
- Consulting with the Team Manager on all matters and specifically on any problems with team members.
- The athlete's physical, mental and emotional well-being whilst on tour.
- Ensuring that the athlete's meals/diet, sleeping habits and recreation are conducive to optimum tournament performance.
- Fostering team spirit to enable all athletes to participate and perform at their best.

**Qualifications, Skills, Experience**

- Be an accredited Club Development or Talent Development Coach.
- Holder of a current First Aid certification.
- Be medically fit to attend the AJC and travel interstate.
- Be considered compatible with other team athletes and officials.

**Other Requirements**

- Attend all training / Sport Science / Sports Physiology sessions.
- Attend tournaments regularly.
- Have no outstanding financial obligations to Squash SA in order to hold a position in a State Team.
- Holder of a current drivers licence.
- Undertake or hold a current DCSI working with children clearance.
- Comply with the SRASA Member Protection Policy in accordance with the current legislation.
