Life Well Lived

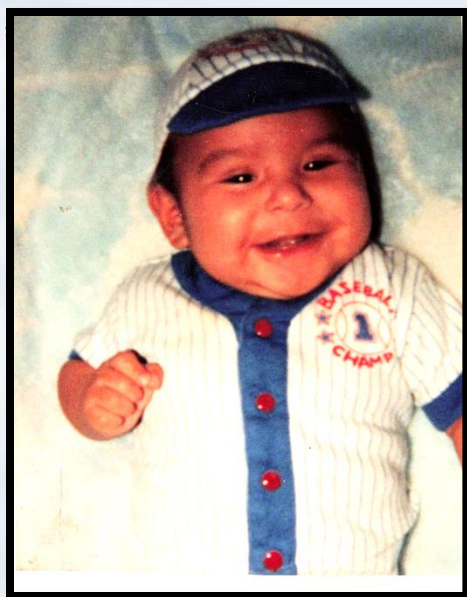
