



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### 1 When will the conference take place?

NTI will still be held from November 11-13, 2020, and all sessions will take place on Zoom. Attendees will receive Zoom links and more information via email closer to the conference dates

### 2 How many sessions can I watch?

All of them! Select sessions, as well as all plenaries, will be live-streamed during the normal conference times on November 11-13. All registered attendees will also receive access to all conference sessions that are not being live-streamed. This will allow you to watch them at your leisure or refer back to the content at a later date!

### 3 Can I still get CEUs?

Yes! CEUs, provided by the Institute on Violence, Abuse and Trauma, will only be available for live sessions due to APA certification restrictions. However, this will not reduce the amount of hours you would typically be able to receive, as usually attendees could only attend one session per time slot in the past. Staff will be monitoring all live sessions to confirm attendance. You must pay for CEU credits during your registration in order to receive credit.

### 4 Is the registration price reduced since the conference is virtual?

Absolutely. The conference price has been decreased drastically to reflect the differences in a virtual event. We are also honoring the regular registration rate through the start of the event, instead of charging a late registration price. More information on rates can be found on the website here.

### 5 Will I be able to network with other attendees and presenters during the event?

Yes! We are currently working on the best option for networking. This will likely involve an online group (ex: Facebook, Google groups) for attendees to meet, chat, and engage with presenters.

### 6 I'm not currently working in the office. How will I receive the USB?

All registered attendees will receive a USB with materials for the conference, included PDFs of presentations. Additionally, all registered attendees will receive a link to fill in their current mailing address for the USBs. If you do not complete this form, the USB will be mailed to the address on your registration form.

### 7 I've already made a hotel reservation. What do I do?

If you have made a reservation at the Hilton, please cancel it as soon as possible. The Hilton will be releasing all room reservations in the next few weeks, but we do recommend contacting them directly to ensure that your reservation has been cancelled.
