

Remembering the life of Stan Sigette...

Stanley Edward Sigette passed away Sept 23, 2024 at CHI St. Alexius Health Devils Lake, with his loving family by his side. He was born to Edward and Pearl (Johnson) Sigette on April 4, 1940 in McVille, ND, and was the oldest of six children.

Stan was raised and educated in McVille, Tolna. Warwick, and spent one year attending Benson County Ag and Training School in Maddock. He graduated with the class of 1958 in Warwick, ND.
