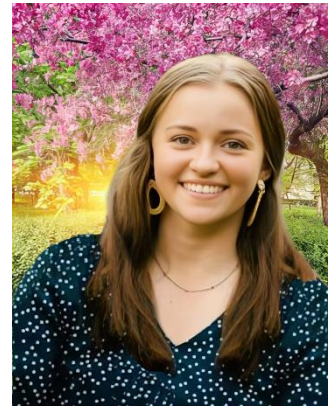


# Sheyenne K. Saxby
