After completing country school, Esther lived with her sister Irene in Fairbury, IL during the school year and returned to the family farm during the summers. Esther graduated from Fairbury High School, and was the first of her family to do so. She was united in marriage to Raymond (Pete) Lembcke on May 11, 1955 at Assumption Catholic Church in Morris. The couple made their home on Pete's family farm, where they took over operations and raised their seven children. Esther later helped her children with watching her grandchildren when needed. In 2006, Esther and Pete moved to Morris. Pete passed away June 29, 2015. Esther continued to live in Morris until the time of her death.

Esther was a member of Assumption Catholic Church and Women's Guild. She enjoyed reading, crocheting, puzzles, playing cards, camping and traveling. Esther and Pete went on several bus tours over the years. Esther was an excellent cook and loved to bake. Most of all, Esther cherished the time spent with her family.

Esther died peacefully on Saturday, June 17, 2023, at the West Wind Village in Morris. She was 88 years old.
