## After-School Extracurricular Opportunities

Beginning in November we are excited to offer some new after school activities for students. If your child doesn't typically stay for after-school care, we still want to invite them to participate in any of these activities they choose. On Mondays and Wednesdays Emmanuel LiFranc, who teaches French in the public schools, is offering to teach French to children and adults who want to learn the language. These classes will be held from 3:30-4:30. On Thursdays, Ms. Diane LaFlair will be starting a baton twirling club if enough students are interested. The cost for any of these

activities will be \$3 per day. If students are already in after-care there is no extra charge, except for approximately \$20 for a baton. Parents must ensure that students have transportation home. If they are not picked up by 4:30, parents will be charged for after-school care at the standard rates. Please contact Mrs. King in the office to let her know if you intend for your young person to participate in any of these activities so leaders know how many to plan for.

## Half Day Coming Up

Next Thursday is a half day as the end of the quarter is Friday and teachers need time to start working on report cards. After-school care will be available from 12:00-5:30, but it is imperative that any student who is staying has a full lunch from home as no school lunch will be served. The parent of any student who does not have a lunch will be called to bring him/her a meal.
