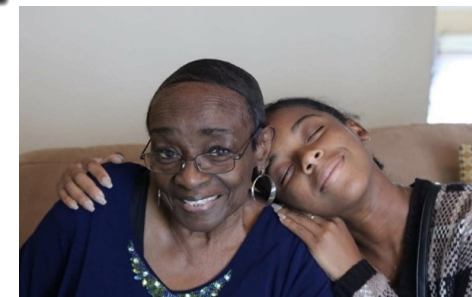
Mrs. Margie Ann Byrd McNeal, of Savannah Georgia went home to be with the Lord on April 17, 2021. She was 81.
