# Obituary

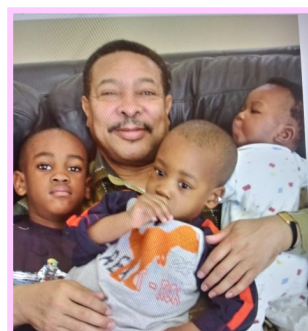
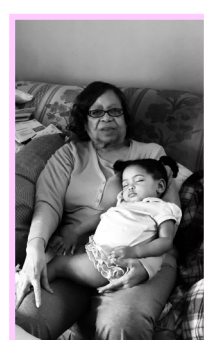
