spending much of his time in Africa, until honorably discharged in 1967.

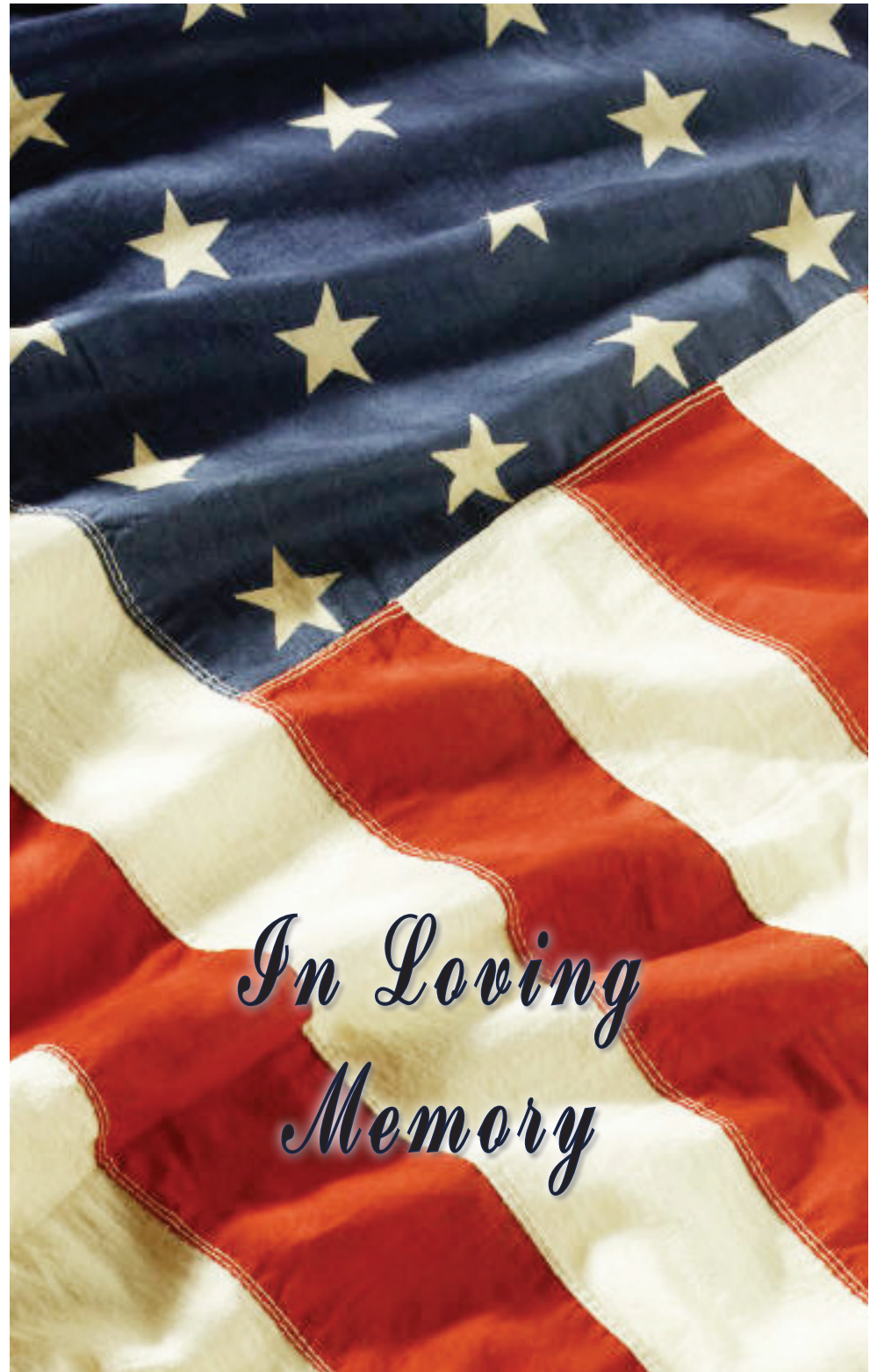
In 1977, Duane married Carol (Kilen) Zimmerman in Almont, ND. They held each other's hand for 41 years.
