great grandchildren: Isaiah, Aubreianna, Kaiden and Johnnie.;

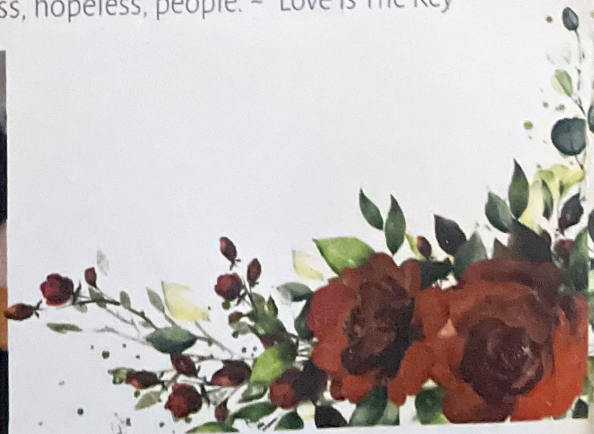
