## **Unmistakably clear**

It is unmistakably clear: if we remove the concept of God as all-powerful Creator from Scripture, we destroy the essential foundation of the Christian faith. We cannot have God and evolution too, because the creation motif permeates the language and theology of Scripture. It is clear from Scripture that if we throw out the concept of God as all-powerful Creator as literally told in the first chapters of Genesis, we literally gut the power of Scripture and the power of the Christian faith. The Creator theme is not limited to the first book of Scripture, but is rather the cornerstone of the doctrine of God—and everything associated with Him. The Christian faith, as taught in Scripture, cannot exist without God as Creator,

fashioning the world in six days. Let me illustrate . . .

## **Evolution is one of Satan's direct attacks on God's authority**

The fact that four of the most basic Biblical truths are wiped-out by embracing a materialistic (even theistic) evolutionary model of origins should be no surprise to us. After all, Lucifer intended from the very beginning of his rebellion to usurp God's place (Isaiah 14:12-14)--and he cannot do so unless he strips God (specifically Christ) of His role as Creator. Notice the following two quotes that affirm this very fact: that evolution is a necessary conclusion to exclude God from the picture—not because there is overwhelming evidence in its support. ## **Atheism, not science**

Philip Johnson, Harvard grad, professor emeritus of law at UC Berkeley, “Modern science protects its grand theory of evolution by starting with the basic assumption that God is out of the picture and by sticking to that assumption through every discouragement.” *Defeating Darwinism by Opening Minds*, pg. 88. Richard Lewontin, high-profile evolutionary scientist: “We take the side of science in spite of the patent absurdity of some of its constructs, in spite of its failure to fulfill many of its extravagant promises of health and life, in spite of the tolerance of the scientific community for unsubstantiated just-so stories, because we have a prior commitment, a commitment to materialism. It is not that the methods and institutions of science somehow compel us to accept a material explanation of the phenomenal world, but, on the contrary, that we are forced by our a priori adherence to material causes to create an apparatus of investigation and a set of concepts that produce material explanations, no matter how mystifying to the uninitiated. Moreover, that materialism is an absolute, for we cannot allow a Divine Foot in the door.” *Billions and Billions of Demons*, *The New York Review*, January 9, 1997.

## **Conclusion**
