The Master Angler

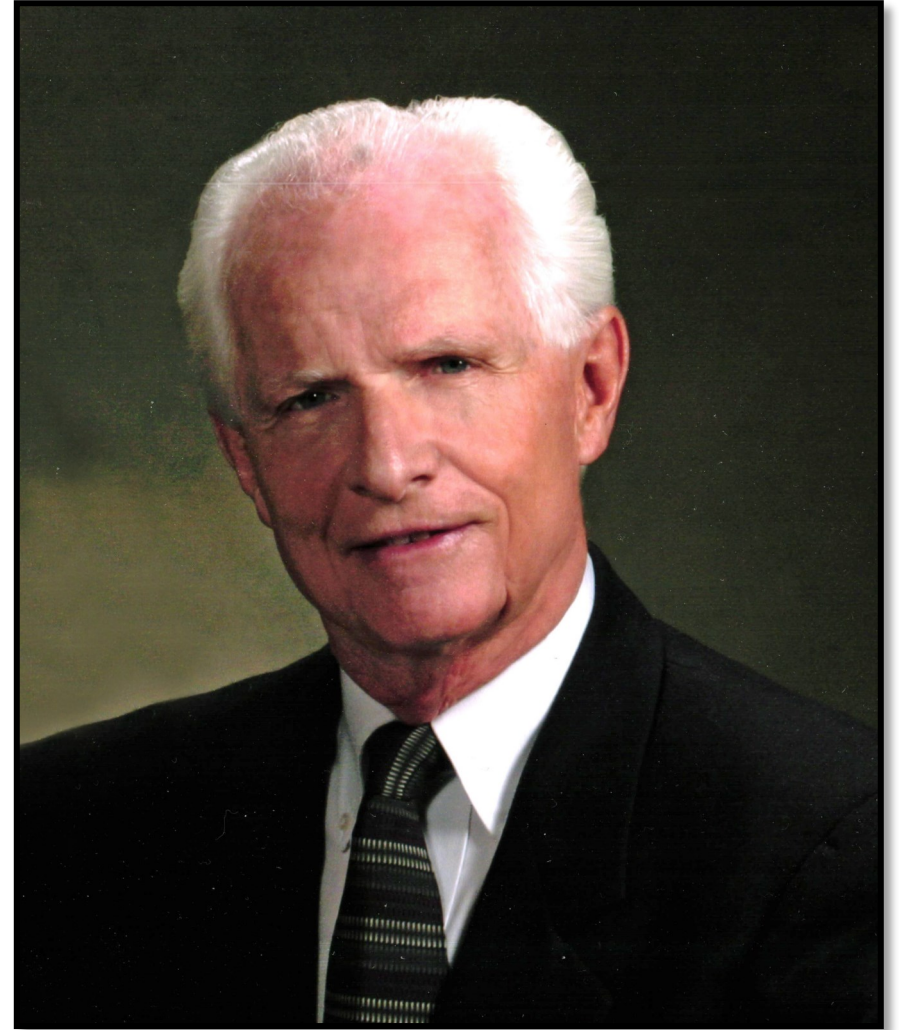
Holding the rod tight, strait narrow his way,
