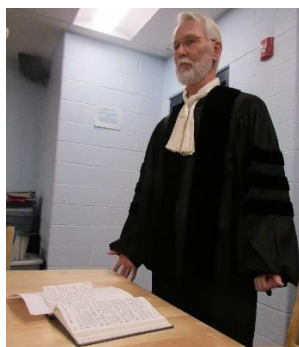
Grades 5-8:Ms. Gravatt

This week has been a Week of Spiritual Emphasis. We "met" several of the Protestant Reformers. Pastor Dubee introduced us to William Tyndale who was known to have translated the Bible into the language of the common person in England. Tuesday, Pastor Kim shared Ulrich Zwingli, who was a leader of the Reformation in Switzerland. Five hundred and one years ago, on October 31, Martin Luther nailed his 95 theses to the door on the Whittenburg Castle Church. We followed Mr. White (Martin Luther) to the Whittenburg Church for the reenactment of this important event. Thursday, we met John Wesley (Pastor Whitney) who told us about himself and his song-composing brother Charles Wesley. Methodism, a new religious denomination rose out of their teachings. Our early Adventist leaders came out of Methodism. Friday, we learned about the Waldensians, who were preservers of biblical truth and kept the

seventh-day Sabbath even while under persecution. They engaged in widespread missionary activity and planted the seeds of the Reformation in Europe.
