- 6. No claims whatsoever will be recognised should any player receive injury whilst participating in the Championships.
- 7. Tournament ball will be a Dunlop double dot although a single dot can be used if both players agree.
- 8. Tournament scoring will be Point A Rally (PAR) 15.
