Our hearts are broken but we Know that God only takes the Best!

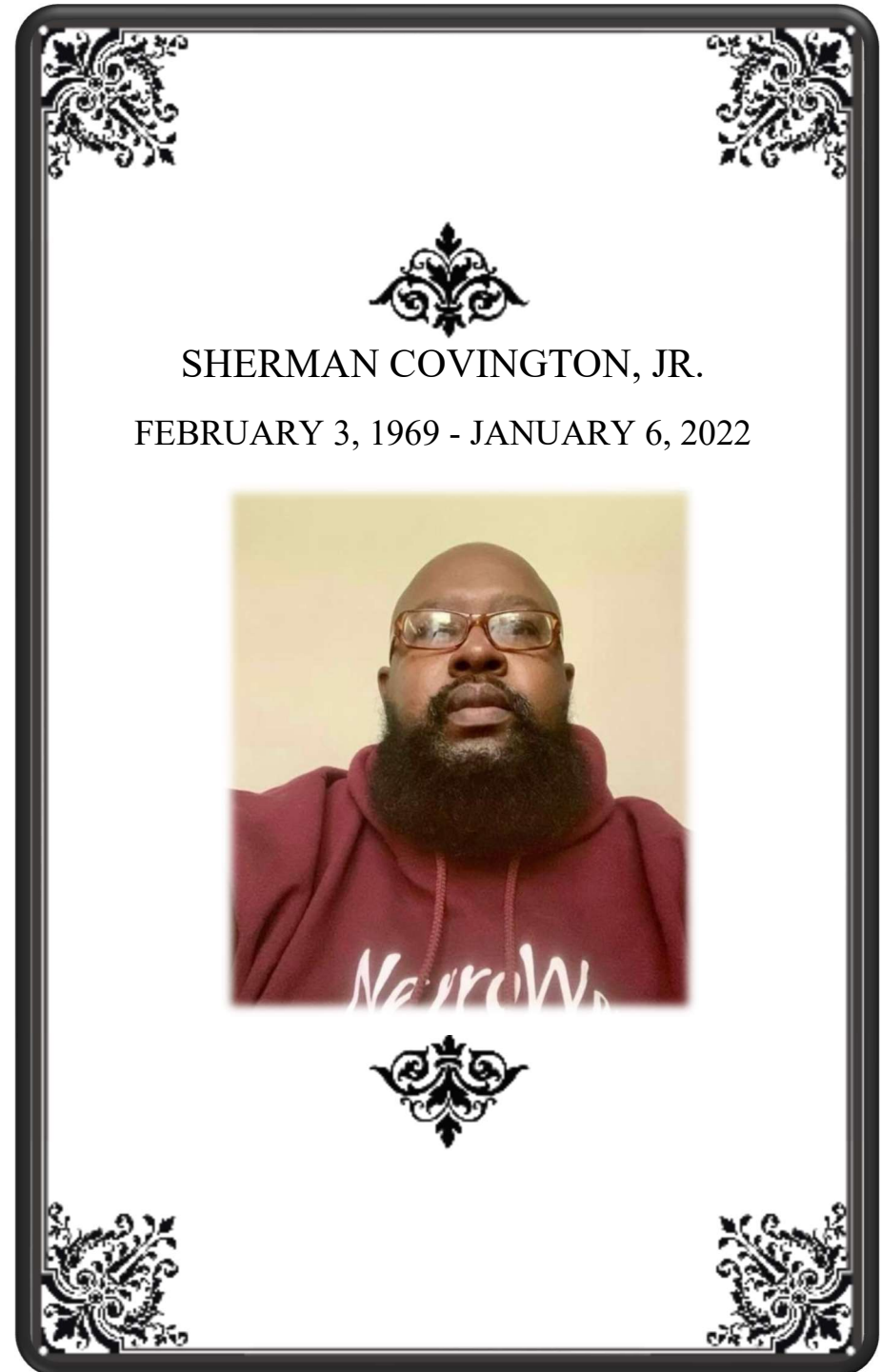
