## A Message from the Principal...

Dear Parents,

A short but very important message from me this week.

As we continue to monitor the Covid-19 infection rates in our county, we are seeing that there has been a steady increase in new infections over the past two weeks. We are very blessed this year as thus far the NCS community has remained safe and uninfected. I am appealing to you to help us keep this going. For many weeks before the start of school this year, my team and private school leaders across our state fought hard for permission to open our schools. As most public schools remain closed today, the behind the scenes fight with state officials to keep NCS open is intense and ongoing. I want to thank everyone who campaigned on our behalf and for those who joined the Pierce County Parents Facebook page. But beyond the advocacy work, please help keep our NCS community healthy and safe by following community protocols, mask mandates, heightened hygiene and sanitary practices, and limited exposure to large groups.
