JRF's research also showed that many of the most vulnerable groups continue to be at higher risk of living in poverty, including families receiving Universal Credit, people in social rented and private rented accommodation, and households including a disabled person or informal carer. Let justice roll down like waters and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream.
