THE ORGANIZATION

Squash BC is a not-for-profit Provincial Sport Organization whose mission is to *“provide leadership and direction for the growth and development of the sport of squash in BC.”*

Squash BC has over 35 Member Clubs and 2,100 individual members around the province of BC.

THE BOARD

The Squash BC Board consists of a President, Past Director and seven (7) directors who are responsible for the oversight of Squash BC and are accountable to our members. The Board of Directors approves the Squash BC strategic plan, sets priorities for the organization, approves and monitors the budget, assesses the organization's risk profile and monitors the performance of the Squash BC Executive Director through the President.

The membership elects 50% of its directors annually for a two (2) year term at the Annual General Meeting scheduled for May 23, 2020.

NOMINATION PROCESS

March	Distribute expression of interest to all member clubs, via Sport, Sport BC and Squash BC e-newsletter
March - April	Interested members complete and submit a Nominations Form to the Coordinator of Member Services and Operations at Office@SquashBC.com
April	Personal discussions with each person who has expressed interest in becoming a director with a Nominations Committee member
April 19, 2020	Nominations close
Early May	Nominations Committee Report is circulated to member clubs approx. 21 days prior to the May 23, 2020 AGM.
May 23, 2020	If more than four directors are nominated there will be an election by private ballot. If there are four nominees, they will be declared elected by acclamation.
