Poem

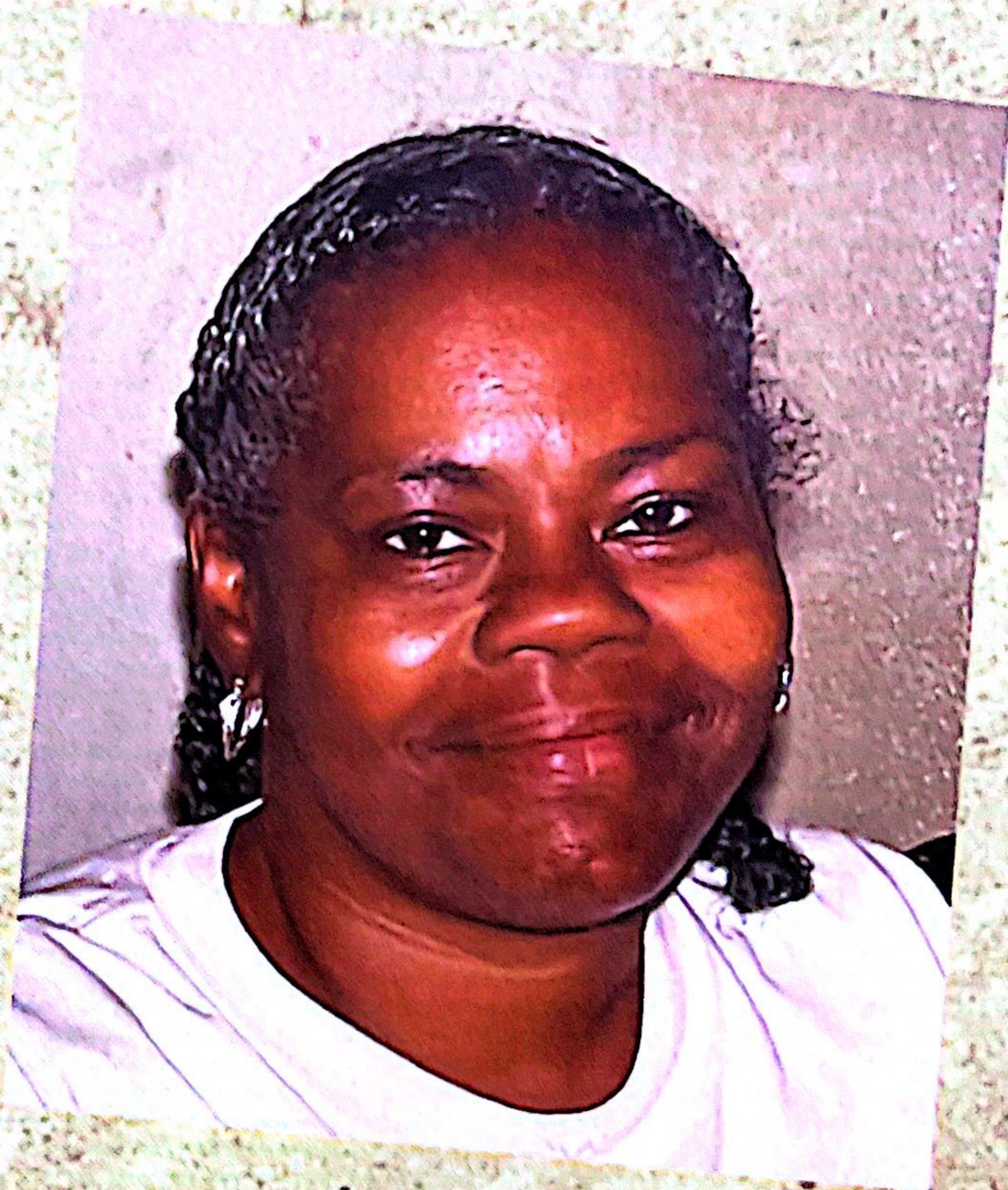
A LETTER FROM HEAVEN
