RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CORONAVIRUS SITUATION

As the COVID-19 (coronavirus) continues to expand shutting down whole cities affecting millions of residents in its wake, this is a good time to be reminded that all citizens should be “Two-Weeks Ready.” Let preparation be the alternative to stress or panic. Two-Weeks Ready includes keeping on hand sufficient food, water, and prescriptions for two weeks. To see how to build your own Emergency Kit, go to <https://mil.wa.gov/preparedness>. As you prepare, encourage your friends and neighbors to prepare as well.

It's unclear how easily this virus spreads from person to person, but the CDC recommends that anyone who may have been exposed to the illness monitor themselves for 14-days after close contact with an infected person. Symptoms to watch for include fever, cough, shortness of breath, trouble breathing, body aches, sore throat or vomiting and diarrhea.

Protect yourself and others from getting sick: wash your hands frequently.

Avoid close contact when you are experiencing cough and fever.

If you have fever, cough, and difficulty breathing, seek medical care early.

When coughing and sneezing, over your mouth and nose with a flexed elbow or tissue; throw tissue into closed bin immediately after use.

Clean hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water after coughing or sneezing and when caring for the sick.

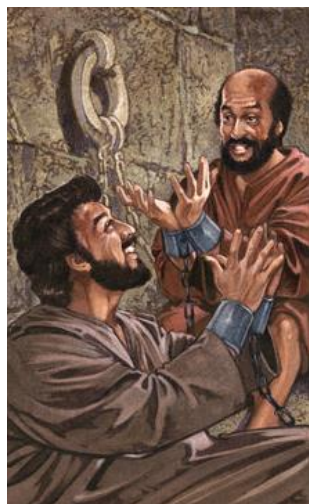
