---

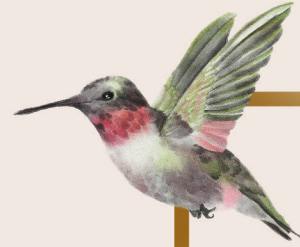
*One night I dreamed a dream.
