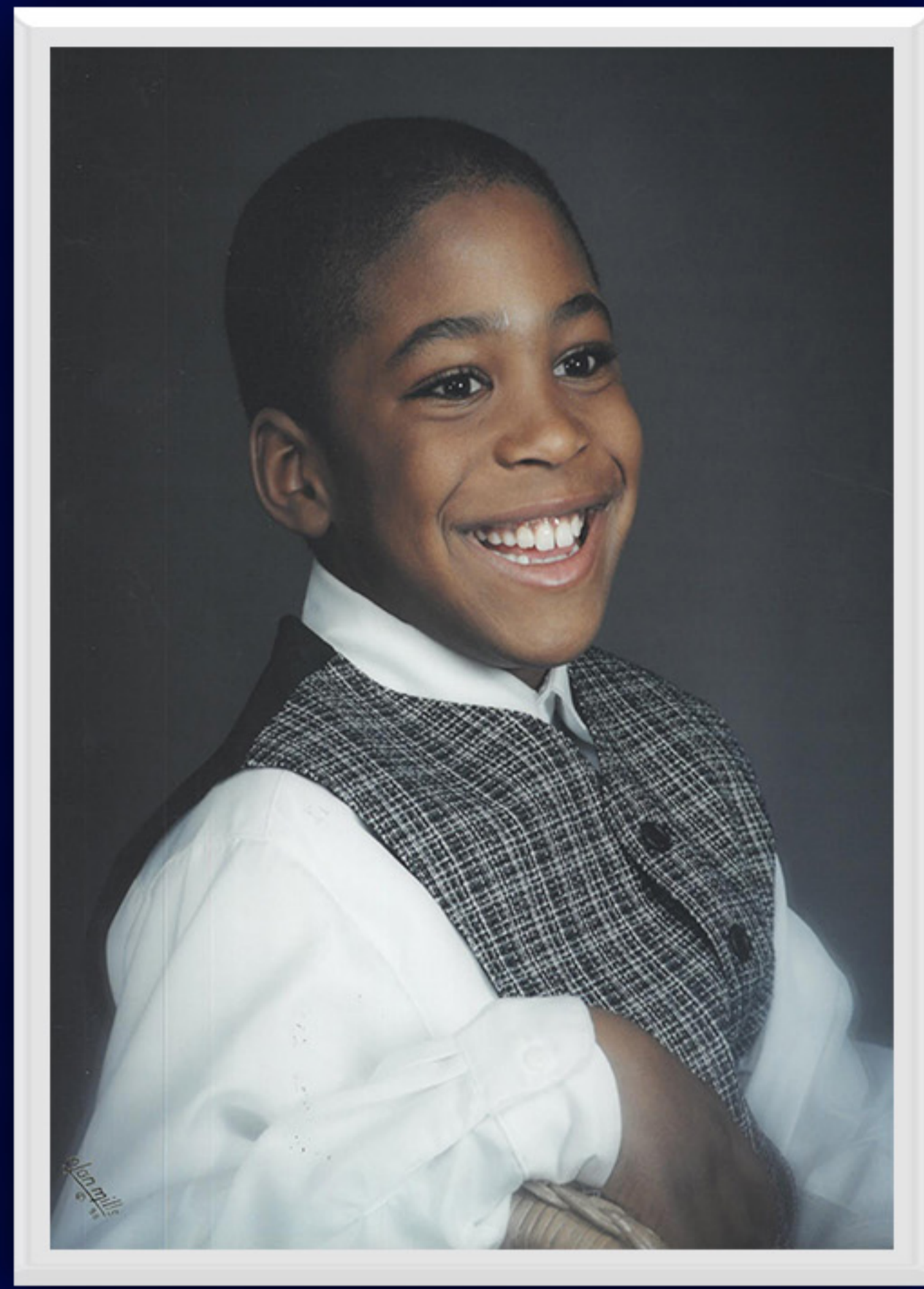

# Vernon ISAAC PEPPERS

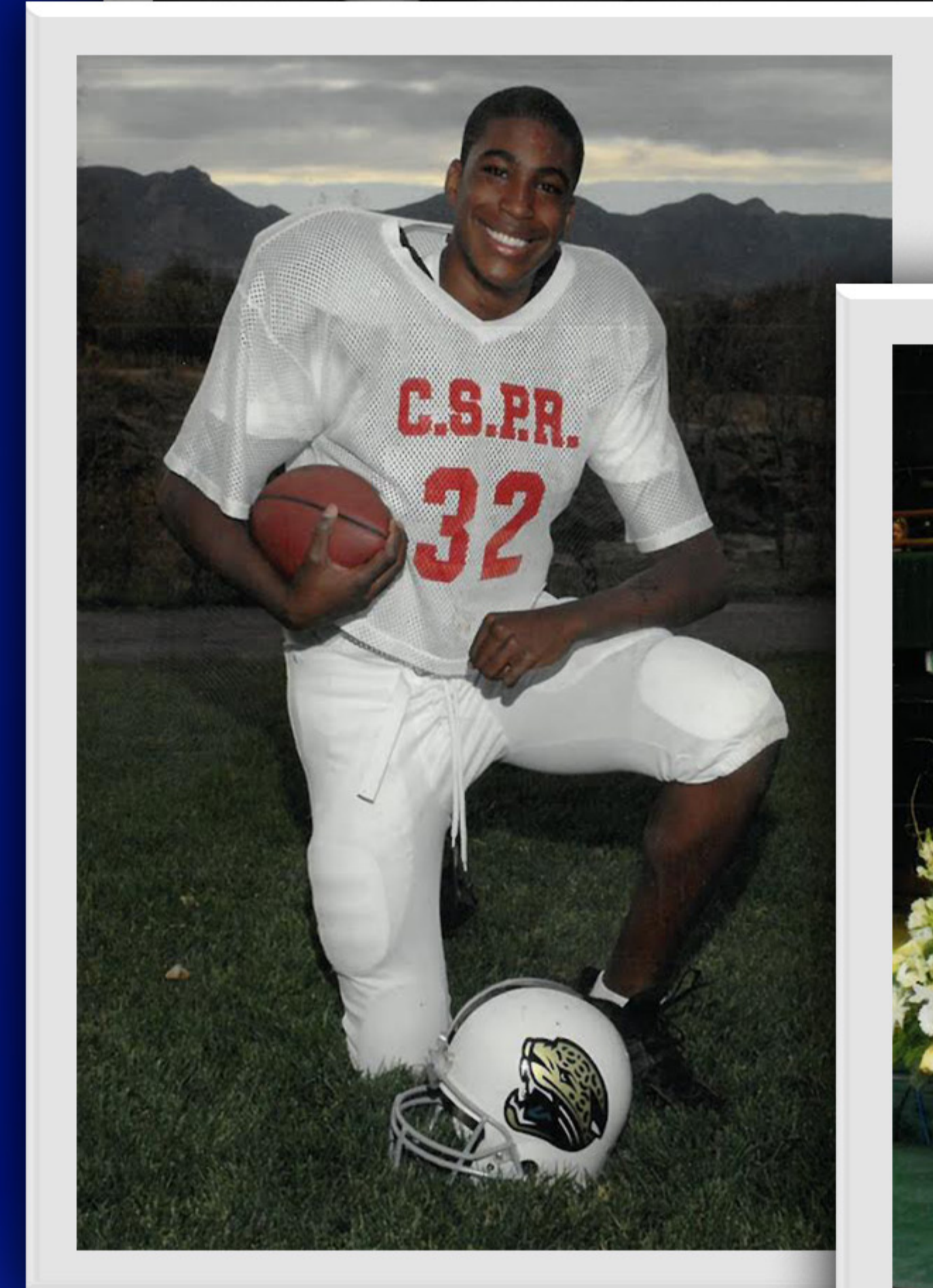
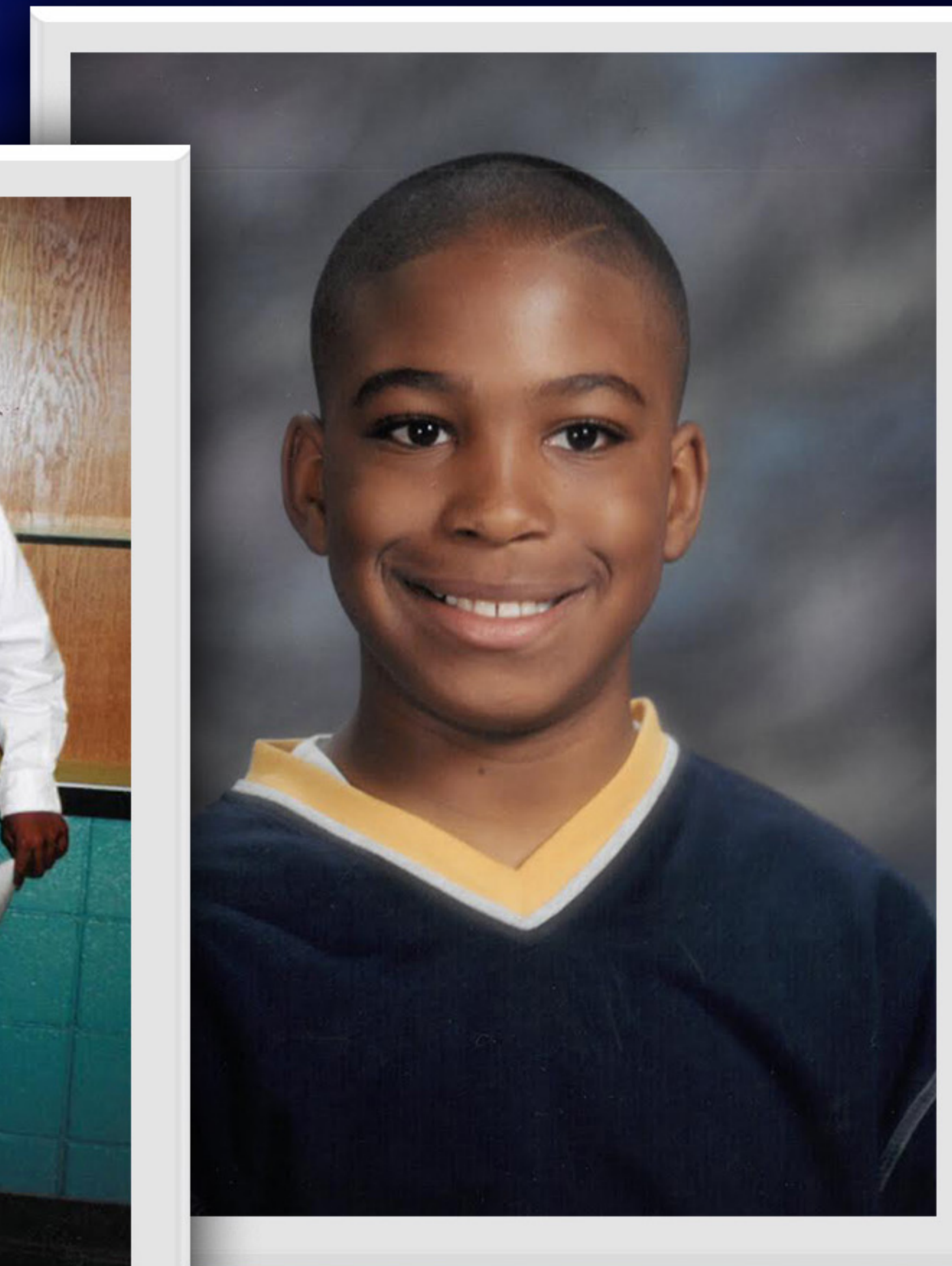
