Dave grew up on his family farm with his siblings; Bonnie, Tim, and Becky. He attended Waseca High School and later Minnesota State University, Mankato, where he met his "sunshine", Gloria Luthi.

Dave was united in marriage to Gloria Luthi on September 2, 1972, in Hancock, Minnesota. They eventually made their home in Starbuck, Minnesota, where they raised their three children, Chris, Kelly, and Kyle.

In 1978, Dave & Gloria opened their convenience store, the Mini-Waska 76. After 20 years, Dave sold the convenience store and opened Dave's Doo Wop Coffee Shop. For the next 20 years, Dave lived out his dream of running a coffee shop where he became known for his pizza and famous chicken salad. Throughout his career, Dave connected with everyone he met, whether it was telling stories, showing off his 50s and 60s memorabilia, or lending a listening ear.

Dave had many roles throughout his life, from chairman of the school board to church council president to Mission Mexico International president, but his favorite roles were being a husband, father, and grandfather. Dave loved fiercely, laughed often, and showed kindness to everyone he met. He is loved by so many and will be greatly missed.

David died on December 8, 2023, surrounded by his family at his home in Starbuck, he was 72 years old.
