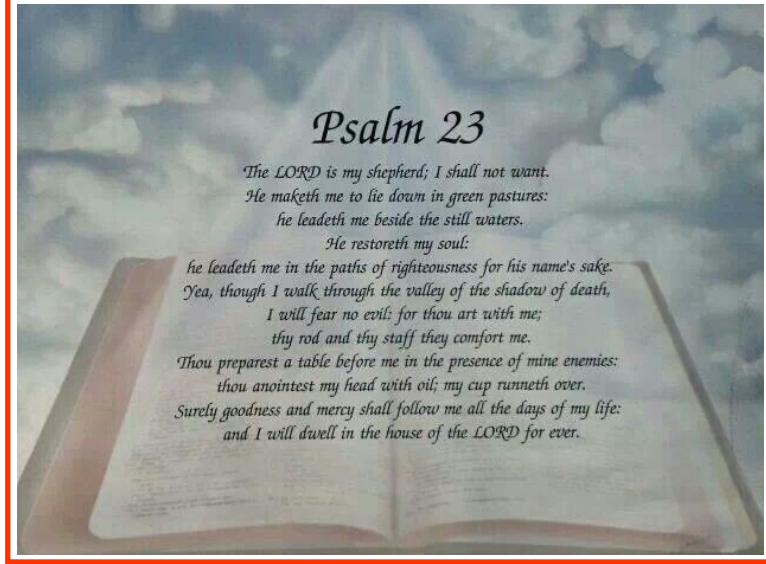


*• TO THOSE I LOVE •
