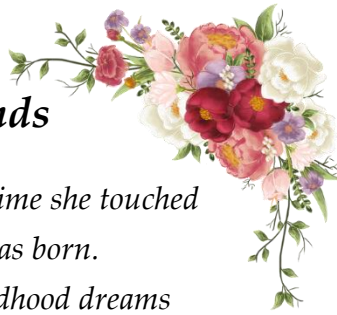


My Mother's Hands

She can bake bread and sew once again.

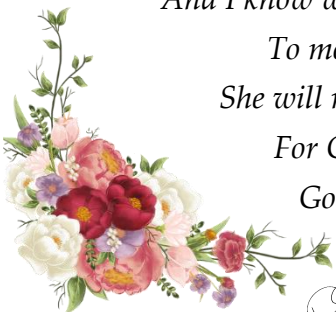
And I know when she passes from life's rocky shores
