### For Today: No Limits

God's power over us has no limits. The all-seeing God is also God almighty with limitless resources of power. One evidence of God's power is the amazing complexity of our own physical bodies, which He has made for us.

*I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful. (Psalm 139:14)*

We are still looking at the first step that has to be taken to understand the greatness of God, which is to realize how unlimited His presence, His wisdom and knowledge, and His power are. Another example in the Bible where we see God's wisdom and power is in the book of Job.

*Out of the north He comes in golden splendor; God comes in awesome majesty. (Job 37:22)*

In Job 38 to 41, we read about how at this point, God Himself enters the conversation and continues with Elihu's point about His majesty. God sets before Job a tremendous display of His wisdom and power in nature. Then He asks Job if he can match such "majesty" as this.

*Do you have an arm like God's, and can your voice thunder like his? Then adorn yourself with glory and splendor, and clothe yourself in honor and majesty. Unleash the fury of your wrath, look at all who are proud and bring them low. (Job 40:9-11)*

God teaches Job that when he cannot match God's majesty, neither should he find fault
