Chef Clinel Walker is originally from Jamaica and has been an Executive Chef for 35 years with three culinary degrees including Cross Cultural Cuisines, and Chinese Cuisines. He is a Vegetarian Food Instructor from the NAD Health Division. He is well-known in New York City and consults for several restaurants and hotels from casual dining to star rated restaurants and hotels.

Clinel Walker was one of the judges for the New York Art Institute's graduating class of 1999 New York Restaurant School and one of the Chefs who created the event for the American 100 Top Chefs. The past 16 years he has been a Gospel Medical Missionary who consistently travels throughout the country and even throughout the world teaching people how to eat right and live a healthy lifestyle, by using food and their healing power to combat western debilitating lifestyle diseases by the grace of God. He also worked as a colporteur for several years and was the Health Coordinator for the Publishing Department of the Georgia Cumberland Conference. Chef Clinel has received several awards for his work. He also has taken time to feed the homeless and less fortunate throughout Georgia.
