Richard Childress “Ricky” passed away peacefully on the morning of March 29, 2024, at his home with the love of his family and close friends surrounding him.

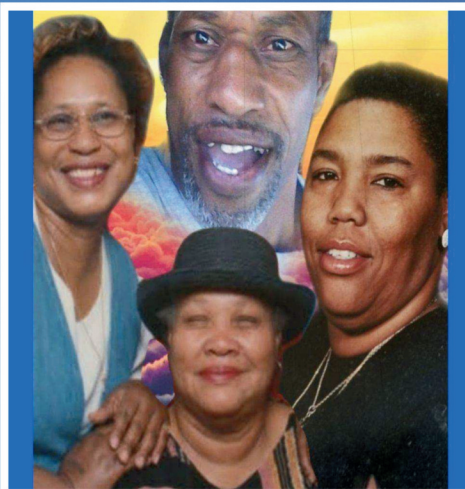
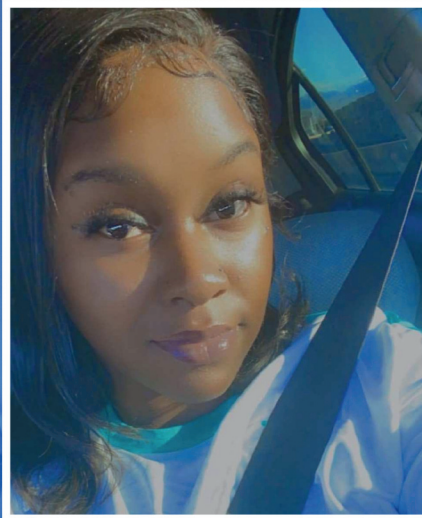
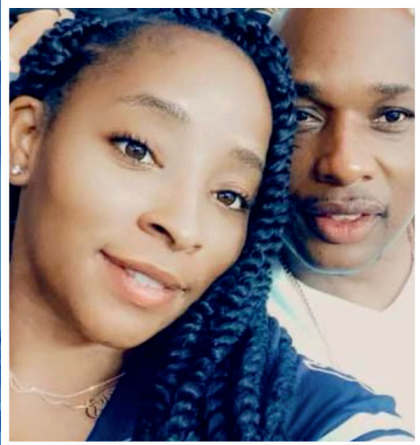

Your memory is our keepsake

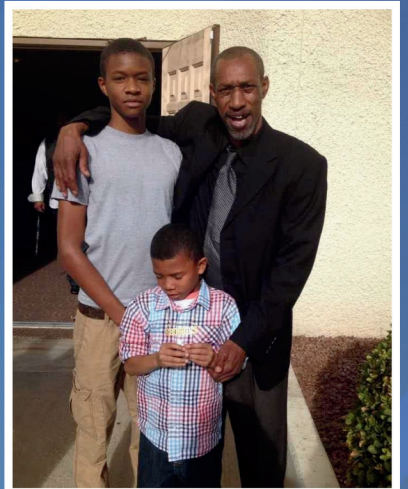
