Church Music Notes

Prelude

The Organ Offertory is **Amazing Grace**, in an arrangement by Bruce Carrico, with a verse from Sharon Rogers (words with Hymn No. 108). John Newton was captain of a slave ship in the 1700's. Later in his career, he was captured and held as a slave himself. He eventually was converted and later became a Christian minister, thus learning by personal experience about the transforming power of God. In 1779 he wrote the words of this hymn as a personal testimony of God's goodness in his life. On his death bed John Newton humbly said: *"My memory is nearly gone, but I remember two things – that I am a great sinner, and that Jesus is a great Savior."* The tune for *Amazing Grace*, first appeared in 1835 in the the early American shaped-note book *Southern Harmony*. Through the years, this hymn has inspired thousands and is undoubtedly one of the most popular sacred songs of all time.

Ellen White once wrote about God's grace in *Steps to Christ*, p. 68: *"In the matchless gift of His Son, God has encircled the whole world with an atmosphere of grace as real as the air which circulates around the globe. All who choose to breathe this life-giving atmosphere will live and grow up to the stature of men and women in Christ Jesus."*

Songs of Praise

The Hymn of Praise is No. 341, **To God Be the Glory**. This beloved gospel hymn was written by Fanny Crosby, of whom it was once descriptively said, *"she is a blind lady whose heart can see splendidly in the sunshine of God's love."* She herself said, *"Darkness may throw a shadow over my outer vision, but there is no cloud that can keep the sunlight of hope from a trustful soul."* The words of this hymn bring to mind Rev. 5:

"In a loud voice they sang: 'Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!' Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, singing: 'To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!' " Written in 1875, this hymn was introduced in England by evangelists Ira Sankey and Dwight Moody. It was immediately popular in England, but almost unknown in America until rediscovered by Billy Graham during his 1952 British crusade.

Offertory



The Offertory music is an arrangement for keyboard of **Bless the Lord, Oh My Soul**, arranged by Don Wyrzten. Gospel musician Andrae Crouch composed this song for the familiar opening phrases of Psalm 103, one of the much-loved Old Testament hymns about God's love and compassion for his people. The Psalm emphasizes that God forgives, heals, provides, and redeems; and that He is gracious, patient, loving, and just.

Postlude

We will end the service with today with an arrangement of **A Mighty Fortress** by David Cherwein for the Organ Postlude (words with No. 506). Both the words and the music of this hymn were written by Martin Luther in 1529. May we may all carry this assurance of God's care with us as we leave today.
