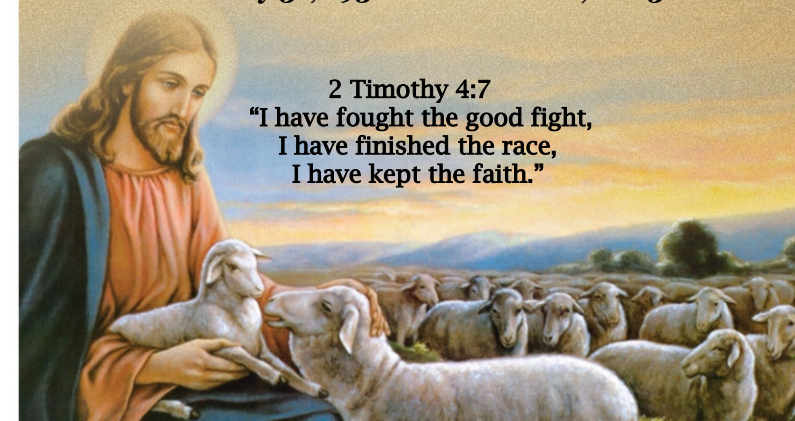

Christine "Chris" J. Glahn, 87, of McPherson, KS, passed away peacefully on Monday, November 6, 2023, at what she considered her home at Loving Care of McPherson. She was a homemaker and most recently worked in the cafeteria at St. Joseph Catholic School.

Chris was born on January 31, 1936, in Salina, Kansas, the daughter of Edward G. and Bessie L. (Turrentine) Bergstrom. She spent her formative years in Salina

and graduated from Salina Central High School. After high school, Chris attended Kansas State University for one year.

On January 24, 1959, she was united in marriage to Donald Robert Glahn in Salina, KS. He preceded her in death on January 28, 2019.
