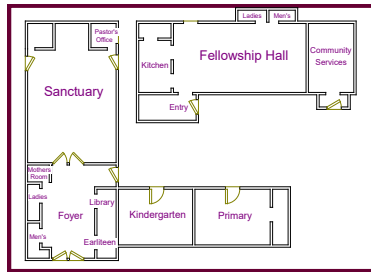


Welcome
