Staffing Changes for Next School Year

Most of you know that we have been trying to start a pre-K program here at Parkview. Earlier in the year we interviewed and voted to hire a pre-K teacher. She accepted, but later declined, deciding that this was not where she wanted to be (she lives in the northwest). We have spent much

time in prayer, seeking God's will for this program and have since come up with a plan which the board has approved. Next year, Ms. Park will teach pre-K and kindergarten with a full time teaching assistant. Developmentally, this is a better combination than kindergarten and first grade. Mrs. Kaiser will teach grades 1-4 and will have a full time teaching assistant as well. Mrs. Hayford will continue to teach grades 5-8 and Mr. Kaiser will continue as Mrs. Hayford's assistant and as P.E. teacher. We anticipate that this arrangement will be for one year and that we will use the next year to secure a fourth teacher so that we can reduce teacher workload the following year.
