simplicity, Remember me.

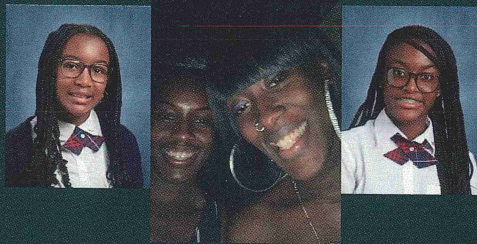
Remember me in your heart:

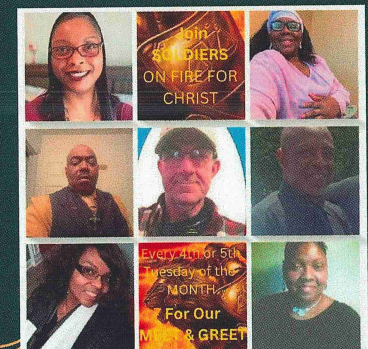
