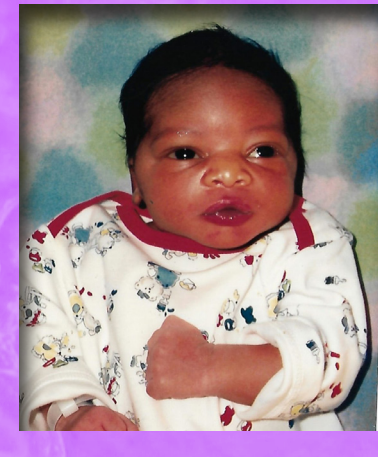
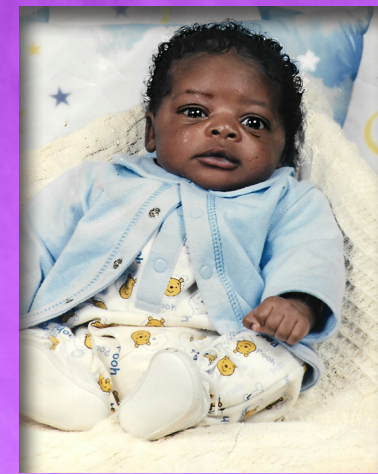




# Tributes
