KATHLEEN MARIE SPEARS was born to Beatrice Thompson and Tom Spears on November 18, 1950 in Dallas, TX.

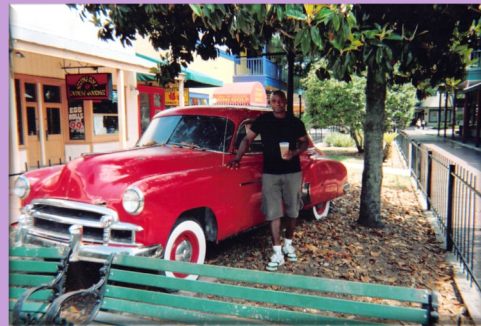
