so bright, so fresh, so new.

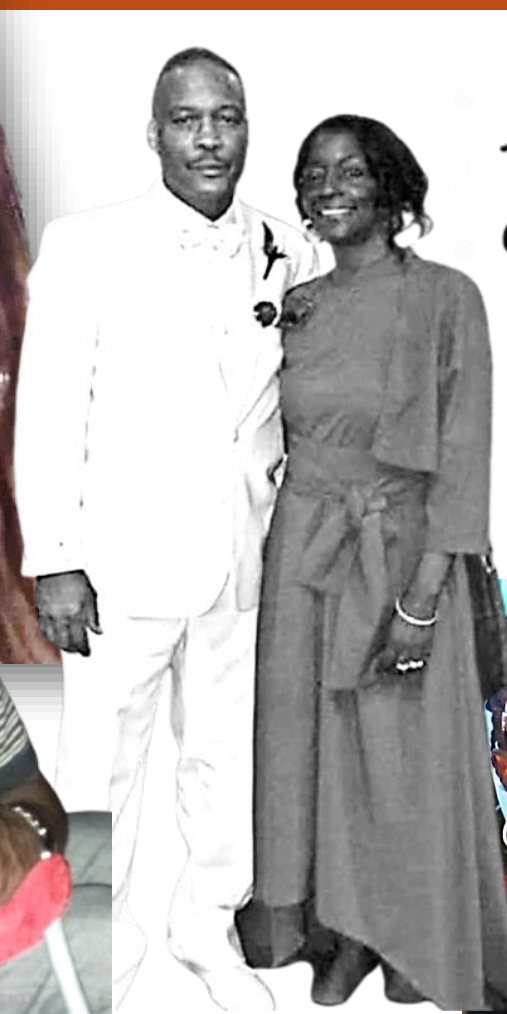
I wish that you could
