## Principal's Message

A word from Mrs. Bryant

“Group” photo paperwork is coming home today. You’ll recall that we aren’t doing traditional group photos this year. If you choose to order, you will receive an 8x10 with every student’s individual picture in your student’s class.

Orders are due by March 15. You may either return the envelope sent home or order online with the code on the flyer.

## Classroom Placement

As you go through the registration process, you’ll note the option to put in a classroom placement request. Just a few notes about our process to help clarify any questions you might have.

1. We certainly want you to have a positive relationship with your child’s teacher and we try to accommodate placement requests as much as possible, however our first priority is to create balance in the classrooms. We want an even mix of boys and girls, grade levels, and ability levels. We want every student to have a friend, but we don’t want any exclusive cliques to develop. These are all things we keep in mind as we’re assigning classroom placement.

2. We date stamp and number every classroom placement form that is turned in, so if you feel strongly about your request, you should get your form turned in as soon as possible. If, for example, I need another 5th grade girl to balance out a classroom, someone who is 9th in line has priority over someone who is 17th in line (not for registration, necessarily, but for those specific placement forms.)

3. Classroom placement is published two weeks before the first day of school. Once published, classroom placement is final.

4. ALL of our teachers are good. If they weren’t, they wouldn’t be teaching at Rogers.

## Registration for 21-22 school year

Open now!

Registration is open. Check your email for the link or visit our website as well.

Tuition for students in grades K-6 will be \$455 and tuition for students in grades 7-8 will be \$465 per month.

All other fees remain flat (technology, school supplies, etc.) as well as enrollment fees. As usual, we are offering three different enrollment fee rates:

- “Early” Enrollment: \$175 per child if paid by March 31.
- “Regular” Enrollment: \$225 per child if paid by June 6.
- “Summer” Enrollment: \$250 per child paid before the first day of the 21-22 school year

Quick reminder about our registration timeline:

**March 1:** Registration opens. If a current student registers and pays enrollment fees anytime in March, their spot will be saved. Mrs. McCrery will send you a registration link via Renweb so you can complete this task. Enrollment fees are \$175 per child during this month.

**April 1:** Registration will open for ALL students, both new and returning. If a current RAS student has not completed registration/paid enrollment fees by March 31, their spot will go to the next person on the list. Enrollment fees are \$225 until June 6.


