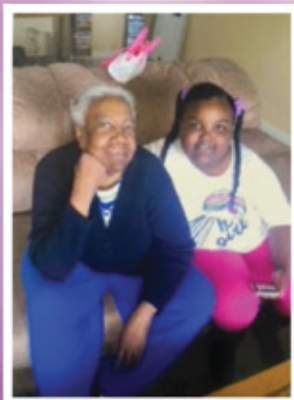
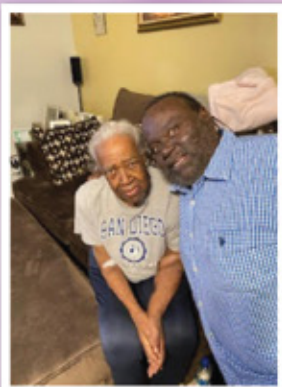

THE LIFE AND LEGACY OF *Catherine Malone*

Catherine Malone was born July 1, 1941, to the late R.D. and Beulah Mae Pendleton in Harrisville, Mississippi. She was the 3rd of the couple's six children. She embraced the nickname "Kitty or Cat" at a young age. Kitty is preceded in death by her parents, Husband Willie Malone, sister Brenda Diane Pendleton, brother R.D. "Jr." Pendleton, sons Willie T. Malone and James (Chookie) E. Giles and daughters Donna Lynn Malone and Dorothy Malone, grandchildren; Tjuan Folk, Lachristopher Giles Jr. and Nihja Dorsey.

In 1948, the family moved to Los Angeles, California and resided in the Palm Lane Housing. Kitty attended schools in the Los Angeles County School District, where she developed a passion for sewing and knitting. Kitty accepted Christ into her life at a very young age, and was baptized at 92nd Street Christian Church.

In 1959, she married the love of her life Willie T. Malone. To this union, five children were born, Tony, Debra (Flossie), Dorothy (Dot), Donna and Willie T. She later united with James Giles and four children were born, James (Chookie), Dwayne, Chavaughnda and Lachristopher.

Kitty was full of joy and laughter. Anytime you couldn't find her, her affectionate laugh would pinpoint her location sooner or later. She enjoyed cooking, dancing, putting puzzles together, word search puzzles, knitting hats and attending Adult Day Centers. Her favorite food to cook was fried chicken, black-eyed peas and cornbread. During family gatherings, everyone was always excited to see kitty dance. She had dance moves that had us all rolling on the floor with laughter. During her quiet times, she would sit and put puzzles together, glue and frame them for gifts. To keep her mind sharp, she did word search puzzles daily. When she wanted a break from the puzzles, she knitted hats. Everyone in the family has received at least one of Kitty's fancy, colorful hats.

In November 2000, Kitty moved to Buena Park with her youngest daughter Chavaughnda to change her atmosphere and focus more on her health and future. Soon after, she decided it was best to retire from cooking and embrace her new lifestyle of having someone take care of her.

In July 2006, Kitty moved to Las Vegas, Nevada, where she was instrumental in raising her grandson Joshua. Kitty later became a member of Mountaintop Faith Ministries under the leadership of Pastor Clinton House, where she was a faithful giver. During the day, she attended the Baby Boomers Adult Day center, where she enjoyed food, fellowship, bingo and arts and crafts. The staff made her feel welcomed and loved. Every day she looked forward to attending the center and being around people her age. She came home with all sorts of goodies she won from playing bingo. Many of her winnings were saved and shared with her granddaughters in California. It brought her a tremendous amount of joy to give to others.

Toward the end of her life, she cherished the times Chris and Flossie came to Las Vegas to spend quality time with her. She also enjoyed spending time with her sister Linda, who resides in Las Vegas. Late afternoon on Sunday, January 8, 2023, Kitty was surrounded by family and friends when she was called to her heavenly home to spend eternal life with her savior.
