Alice Ann (Pickle) Alseth was born on September 24, 1934, in Atwater, Minnesota, the daughter of Ruby (Holmgren) and Joe Pickle. Alice Ann was baptized at her grandparent's home in rural Atwater, confirmed at the Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Atwater. She graduated from Atwater High School in 1952.

After high school, Alice worked in Minneapolis for the Pillsbury Company and the Minneapolis Art Institute.
