Most of us are much more comfortable when we have a routine, and we get to follow that routine. When Simon was a toddler he really struggled with changes of routine and even would often tantrum when he had to transition from one activity to the next. When he expected to be doing one activity and ended up doing something other than what was expected he often lost his ability to cope and would have a meltdown. With my varied schedule it was difficult because my schedule seems to change and vary more than it stays the same. The thing that seems to be constant is change. We learned to give Simon time to transition. Phrases like, “we are going to be leaving in 15 minutes,” or “you need to finish up in about 5 minutes” were often heard around our house because they made transitions easier. We also learned to warn Simon when our schedule was

going to be different for the day. Eventually things got better; Simon came to understand that the things he could always expect were changes and transitions. When it came time for our family to move almost 3 years ago, Simon actually did better than some of the rest of us.




