He then served as pastor at Newman Center and St. John's Church in Wahpeton, St. Mary's Church in Grand Forks, ND and St. Aloysius Church in Lisbon, ND.

He retired from active ministry in June of 2020, and resided in Wahpeton. Fr. Finnestad suffered a stroke on New Year's Day of 2021, and resided in St. Catherine's Living Center until his death.


