I've been thinking a lot about 'building' this week. Anyone who knows me will know I'm a practical guy and love a bit of DIY, I started my working life as a signals and telecoms engineer on the railway. I'm enjoying working with our newly formed Buildings and Maintenance team and we are prioritising some key areas for improvements. Some involve spending money from our limited funds, and some cost very little as we are using the skills, time, and energy we have.

In recent weeks we've seen the gents' urinals in St. Peter's renewed - you may have noticed the nasty smell has gone! The damaged driveway to the Parish Centre has been resurfaced. We've held two Saturday morning working parties to maintain the gardens

around the Parish Centre and St. Peter's Church and jet-washed the Parish Centre steps and ramp. A new large TV screen is purchased and ready to install at Barrow Bridge Mission. Plans are afoot to resurface the main driveways at St. Peter's and improve the paths from the church car park to church. We're also looking at replacing the old carpet in St. Peter's and dreaming about ways to improve the quality and functionality of the building. It feels like momentum is building and we are pulling together effectively as a team!

Ultimately all these activities, be they practical work or growth in our faith as disciples, form part of our call to build the Kingdom of God here on earth as it is in heaven.
