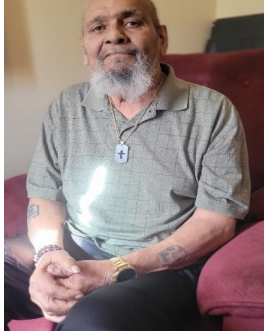
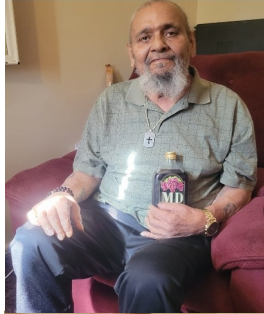

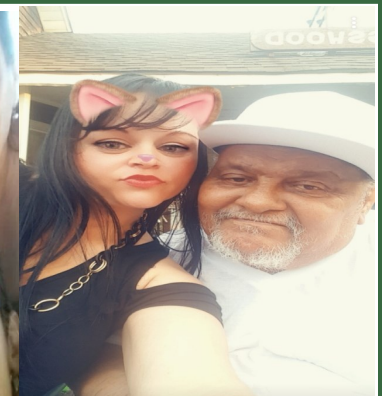
Junior had many passions outside of work including playing dominos and drinking his favorite drink Thunderbird wine later switching to MD 2020.
